

56 x 64 Laptop size

Four-Patch blocks with 8" finished size

Fabric is 40" wide and shrinks 3%, with 2" added to the length requirements for straightening the ends.

Fabric 1 (dark): 1 yard

Fabric 2 (light): 1 yard

***From fabric 1 (dark)
Cut 7 strips, each 4½" wide.

***From fabric 2 (light)
Cut 7 strips, each 4½" wide.

***Sew each of the (seven) 4½" light strips to the 4½" dark strips – right sides together.

***Cut eight (8) 4½" segments from each strip set.



Sew segments together as pictured in the four patch to the left.

You will need 28 four patch blocks.

Next:

Squares with an 8" finished size

Fabric is 40" wide and shrinks 3%, with 2" added to the length requirements for straightening the ends.

Fabric needed: 2 yards

1. Cut 7 strips, each 8½" wide.
2. Cut four (4) 8½" squares from each strip. You will need 28 squares.

Finally:

Sew four patch blocks & solid squares together – alternating placement – as shown in picture below.

7 blocks across, 8 blocks down.
