

63 X 81 - TWIN SIZE

32 Four-Patch blocks, 9" finished size. (Solid fabric)

Fabric is 40" wide and shrinks 3%, with 2" added to the length requirements for straightening the ends.

Fabric 1 (dark): 1¼ yards

Fabric 2 (light): 1¼ yards

From fabric 1 (dark)

Cut 8 strips, each 5" wide.

From fabric 2 (light)

Cut 8 strips, each 5" wide.

Sew each of the (eight) 5" light strips to the (eight) 5" dark strips – right sides together.

Cut (eight) 5" segments from each strip set.

Sew segments together as pictured in the four patch below.



You will need 32 four patch blocks.

Next:

32 Squares with a 9" finished side. (Print fabric)

Fabric is 40" wide and shrinks 3%, with 2" added to the length requirements for straightening the ends.

Fabric needed: 2¼ yards

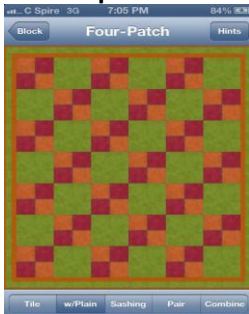
1. Cut 8 strips, each 9½" wide.

2. Cut 4 9½" squares from each strip.

You will need 32 squares.

Finally:

Sew four patch blocks & solid (print fabric) squares together – alternating placement – as shown in picture below.



7 blocks across, 9 blocks down.
