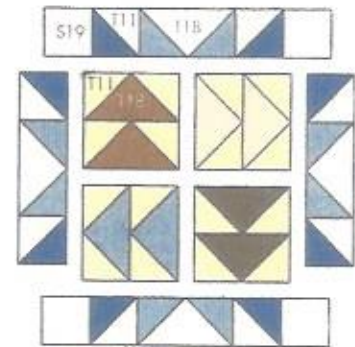


Flying Geese Star
12" x 12" Block



Templates Needed
S19, T11 & T18

Block #2 Flying Geese Star

Cutting Instructions

1. Cut (8) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from one tan, cut each square on one diagonal to make (16) T11 triangles.

Cut (1) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square each from mauve, dark green, blue and dark brown (4 total). Cut each square on both diagonals to make four T18 triangles of each fabric. Set aside two triangles of each color for another project.

Piecing Instructions

1. Referring to the Piecing Diagram to piece one block, sew T11 (tan) to each short side of T18 (mauve dark green, blue and dark brown) line up with bottom of triangle to get a good fit; repeat for eight units.
2. Join (2) same-fabric T11-T18 units; repeat for four units.
3. Join the (4) pieced units to complete the block center.
4. Sew a dark T11 to a light T11 on the diagonal; repeat for eight T11 units.

Sewing the pieces to finish the star border

5. Sew a dark T11 (navy mottled) and light T11 (cream tonal) on the diagonal; repeat for (8) T11 units. Chain piece if you like. Sew a T11 (cream tonal) to the short sides of T18 (blue print) to make a side unit; repeat for four side units. Make sure to match points on the long side to ensure accurate seams. Square up each square and rectangles. NOTE: press one side before sewing the second T11 (cream tonal).
6. Sew a T11 (navy mottled/cream tonal) unit to each short end of a side unit (cream tonal/blue print). Sew a T11 side unit to opposite sides of the pieced center.
7. On two sides sew S19 to opposite ends of the 2 sides of the pieced unit
8. Add borders to original block and press. Block will measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ X $12\frac{1}{2}$ until sewn with other blocks/sashes.

HINT: You can sew all the star borders in advance, then just add to the block for each month.
