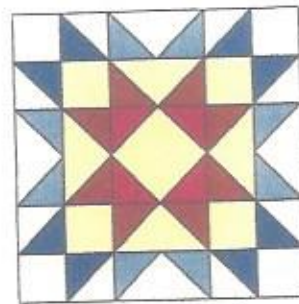


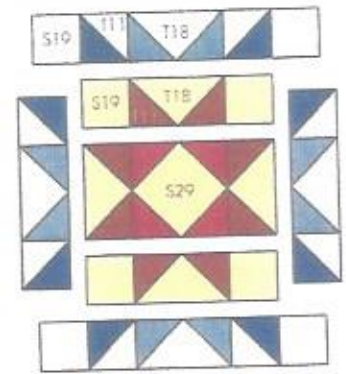
Block #6 Ohio Star-in-a-Star

Cutting Instructions

1. Cut one $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{8}$ " tan S29 square.
2. Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " tan S19 squares.
3. Cut one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " tan square; cut the square on both diagonals to make four T18 triangles.
4. Cut two identical $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from burgundy (dark 1); cut each square on one diagonal to make four T11 triangles.
5. Cut four $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from a second burgundy (dark 2); cut each square on one diagonal to make eight T11 triangles.

Templates Needed
S19, S29, T11 & T18

Piecing Instructions

1. Referring to the Piecing Diagram to piece one block, sew a dark 2 burgundy T11 to each side of S29 tan. NOTE: center the burgundy triangle on each side of the square. Trim off dog ears.
2. Sew a dark 1 burgundy T11 to each short side of tan T18, lining the straight edges; repeat for four units. Trim off dog ears. Sew a unit to opposite sides of the T11-S29 unit.
3. Sew a tan S19 to each end of the of the remaining T11-T18 units; sew these units to the remaining sides of the pieced unit to complete the center block.

Sewing the pieces to finish the star border

1. Sew a dark T11 (navy mottled) and light T11 (cream tonal) on the diagonal; repeat for (8) T11 units. Chain piece if you like. Sew a T11 (cream tonal) to the short sides of T18 (blue print) to make a side unit; repeat for four side units. Make sure to match points on the long side to ensure accurate seams. Square up each square and rectangles. NOTE: press one side before sewing the second T11 (cream tonal).
2. Sew a T11 (navy mottled/cream tonal) unit to each short end of a side unit (cream tonal/blue print). Sew a T11 side unit to opposite sides of the pieced center.
3. On two sides sew S19 to opposite ends of the 2 sides of the pieced unit
4. Add borders to original block and press. Block will measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ X $12\frac{1}{2}$ until sewn with other blocks/sashes.

HINT: You can sew all the star borders in advance, then just add to the block for each month.
