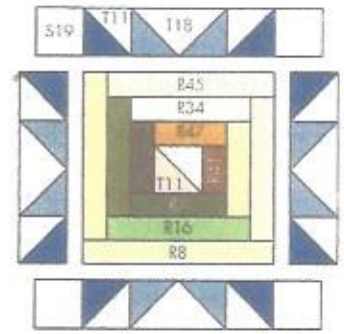


**Log Cabin Star**  
12" x 12" Block



**Templates Needed**  
R7, R8, R16, R34, R41,  
R45, R47, S19, T11 & T18

## Block #5 Log Cabin Star

### Cutting Instructions

1. Cut (1) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" square each light pink (light) and mauve (medium). Cut each square on one diagonal to make (2) T11 triangles of each fabric; set aside one triangle of each fabric for another project.
2. Cut the following rectangles: (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" dark brown R41; (1) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" medium brown R47; (1) dark green 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" R47 and (1) different dark green 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" R7.
3. Cut the following rectangles: (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" tan R7 (light); (1) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" R34 from a different tan (light); (1) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" medium green R34; and (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" R16 from another medium green.
4. Cut the following rectangles: (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" R16 from a third tan (light); and (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" R45 from a fourth tan (light).
5. Cut the following rectangles: (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" light green R45; and (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" R8 from another light green.

### Piecing Instructions

1. Referring to the Piecing Diagram to piece one block, sew a light pink T11 to a medium mauve T11 on the diagonal to make the block center.
2. Beginning with the R41 dark brown, R47 medium brown, R47 dark green, different R7 dark green, R7 tan, R34 different tan, R34 medium green, R16 a different medium green, R16 a third tan, R45 a fourth tan, R45 light green, R8 a different light green.

### Sewing the pieces to finish the star border

6. Sew a dark T11 (navy mottled) and light T11 (cream tonal) on the diagonal; repeat for (8) T11 units. Chain piece if you like. Sew a T11 (cream tonal) to the short sides of T18 (blue print) to make a side unit; repeat for four side units. Make sure to match points on the long side to ensure accurate seams. Square up each square and rectangles. NOTE: press one side before sewing the second T11 (cream tonal).
7. Sew a T11 (navy mottled/cream tonal) unit to each short end of a side unit (cream tonal/blue print). Sew a T11 side unit to opposite sides of the pieced center.

8. On two sides sew S19 to opposite ends of the 2 sides of the pieced unit
9. Add borders to original block and press. Block will measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$  X  $12\frac{1}{2}$  until sewn with other blocks/sashes.

HINT: You can sew all the star borders in advance, then just add to the block for each month.
