



Cutting Corners

Finished Size: 36 x 54"



Fabric Requirements:

Striped or variegated batik print: 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Binding: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Backing: 2 $\frac{1}{3}$ yards (if your backing is 42/43 inches wide you can get by with only 1 $\frac{2}{3}$ yards)

Cutting Instructions:

Be sure to steam press your fabric flat and straighten up the stripes before cutting.

Cut 6@10 inches the WOF. Sub-cut each strip into 4-10" squares for a total of 24 squares.

Pick two squares that look almost exactly alike and lay out right side up on your cutting board like the picture below. Cut the first square along the diagonal from the lower right corner to the upper left corner. Cut the second square along the diagonal from the lower left corner to the upper right corner.



Switch piece B with piece D. Stitch the two triangles into a square. Trim off the dog ears and press the seam allowances to one side.



Repeat this process with the remaining 23 squares.

Lay out the blocks into a 4x6 block pattern and stitch together.

Quilt and bind as desired.

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
