2024 Brandon Quilters Block of the Month – Block 3 Star of the Milky Way

Cutting Instructions:

Color A Cut 4 – 4" squares.

Color B Cut 4 – 4" squares.

Background Cut 8 – 4" squares.


With right sides together, layer a Color A square and a Background square. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner and stitch 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut along the drawn line and press the Half Square Triangle (HST) open with the seam toward Color A. Trim the squares so they measure 3 1/2". Repeat with the remaining Color A squares. Makes 8 Color A/Background HST. Measures 3 1/2".






Repeat the above steps using the Color B squares and the remaining Background squares. Makes 8 Color B/Background HST.

Sew together a Color B HST + Color B HST + Color A HST + Color B HST paying attention to the orientation of the HSTs. Press all the seams in one direction. Make 2. Measures 3 1/2" x 12 1/2".



Sew together a Color A HST + Color A HST + Color A HST + Color B HST paying attention to the orientation of the HSTs. Press all the seams in one direction. Make 2. Measures 3 1/2" x 12 1/2".



Sew the rows together as shown in the picture at the top. Press seams as desired. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
