
2024 Brandon Quilters Block of the Month – Block 5 Louisiana

Cutting Instructions:


Color A Cut 1 – 7 1/4" square.

Color B Cut 4 – 3 7/8" squares.



Background Cut 4 – 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Color B square. With right sides together, place 2 Color B squares on the Color A square on opposite corners. Make sure your drawn line lines up and stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press the smaller Color B triangles away from the larger Color A triangle. Place the remaining Color B squares on the corner of the Color A triangles. Stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press the smaller Color B squares the smaller Color A triangles. Stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press the smaller Color B triangles away from the larger Color A triangle. Makes 4. Measures 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Sew a Background rectangle to the top of each flying geese. Press the seam toward the background. Make 4. Measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Sew the 4 units together as shown in the picture at the top. Press seams as desired. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
