## 2024 Brandon Quilters Block of the Month - Block 6 Sarah's Choice

## **Cutting Instructions:**

Color A

Cut 4 – 3 1/2" squares

Cut 2 - 4" squares

Color B


Cut 4 – 3 1/2" squares

Cut 2 - 4" squares



Cut 4 – 3 1/2" squares

Cut 4 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles



With right sides together, layer a 4" Color A square and a 4" Color B square. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner and stitch 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut along the drawn line and press the Half Square Triangle (HST) open with the seam toward Color B. Trim the squares so they measure 3 1/2". Repeat the other two 4" squares. Makes 4 Color A/Color B HSTs measuring 3 1/2". Sew the 4 HST into a pinwheel with Color B spinning clockwise as shown. The pinwheel should measure 6 1/2" square.







Place a Color B 3 1/2" square right sides together on the left half of a Background rectangle. Draw a line from the bottom left corner to the top right of the Color B square and stitch on that line. Cut 1/4" away from the stitching and flip the 'sky' open.





Now place a Color A 3 1/2" square right sides together on the right half of the unit. Draw a line from the bottom right corner to the top right corner of the Color A square and stitch on that line. Cut 1/4" away fromteh stitching and flip the 'sky' open. The unit should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2". Make 4.






Sew a 3 1/2" Background square to each end of 2 of the flying geese. Press seams towards the background square. This unit should measure 3 1/2"  $\times$  12  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Sew the remaining flying geese to opposite sides of the pinwheel. Press seams towards the pinwheel. This unit should measure  $6\,1/2$ " x  $12\,1/2$ ".



Sew the 3 rows together as show on page 1. Press the seams away from the center. The block should measure  $12\ 1/2$ " x  $\ 12\ 1/2$ ".
