The meeting was then adjourned.






2024 Block of the Month

Tips and Tricks -



Pam Avara went over the steps to make a quilt block board. Supplies needed - foam board, quilt batting, adhesive spray and duct tape. She suggested a solid color tape for the edges, this will not distract from your quilt block as decorative tape might. Pam also introduced some of us to E6000 adhesive spray. It can be found at WalMart near the duct tape and can be used for numerous crafts.




