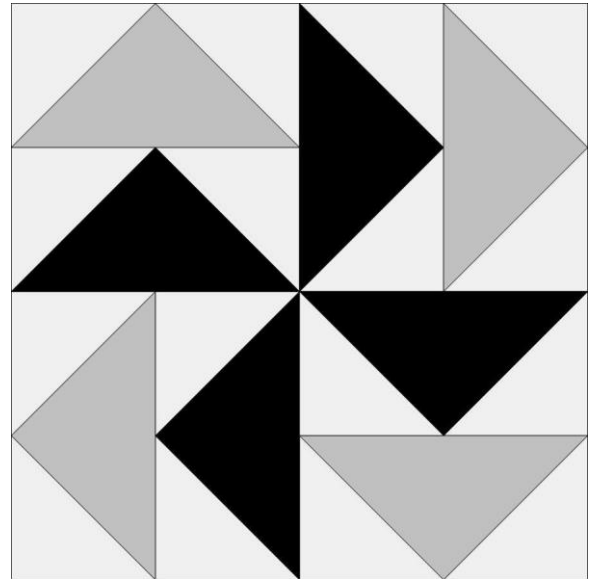


# 2024 Brandon Quilters Block of the Month – Block 10 Dutchman's Puzzle



## Cutting Instructions:



Color A  
Cut 1 – 7 1/2" square

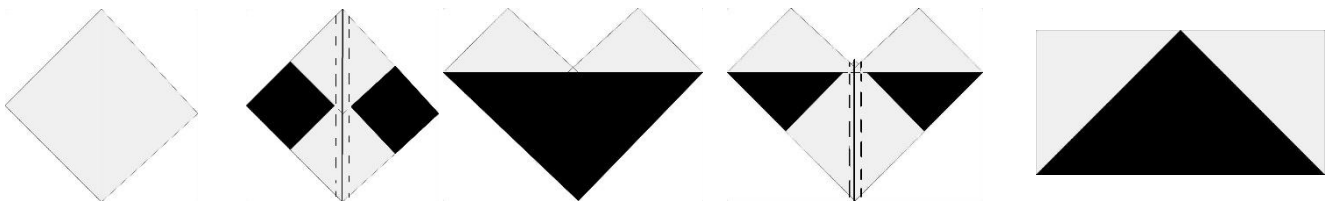


Color B  
Cut 1 – 7 1/2" square



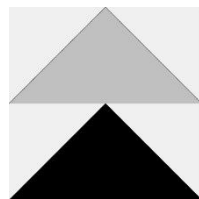
Background  
Cut 8 – 4" squares

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Background square. With right sides together, place 2 background squares on the Color B square on opposite corners. Make sure your drawn line lines up and stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press the smaller Background triangles away from the larger Color B triangle created when cutting the square. Place the remaining Background squares on the corner of the Color B triangles. Stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press the smaller Background triangles away from the larger Color B triangle. Trim to 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Repeat with the remaining Background squares and Color A square. Makes 4 Color A geese and 4 Color B geese.

Sew a Color A goose to the top of a Color B goose. Press the seam to the Color A goose. Each new unit should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Sew the units together as shown at the top of the page. Press seams as desired. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
