

2024 Brandon Quilters Block of the Month – Block 9
Meteor

Cutting Instructions:



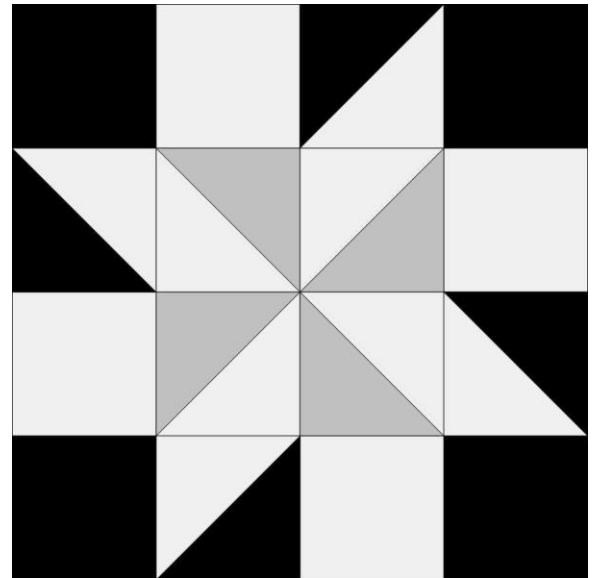
Color A
Cut 2 – 4" squares



Color B
Cut 4 – 3 1/2" squares
Cut 2 – 4" squares



Background
Cut 4 – 4" squares
Cut 4 – 3 1/2" squares



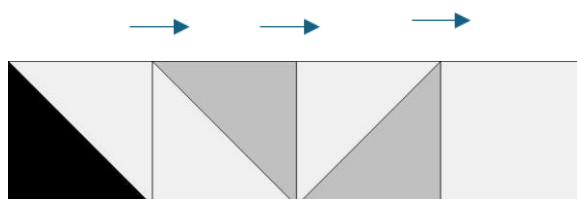
With right sides together, layer a 4" Color A square and a 4" Background Square. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner and stitch 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut along the drawn line and press the Half Square Triangle (HST) open with the seam toward the darker fabric. Trim the squares so they measure 3 1/2". Repeat with the remaining 4" squares. Makes 4 Color A / Background B and 4 Color B / Background HSTs measuring 3 1/2".



Sew together a 3 1/2" Color B square + 3 1/2" Background square + Color B HST + 3 1/2" Color B square paying attention to the orientation of the HST. Press all the seams in one direction. Make 2. Measures 3 1/2" x 12 1/2".



Sew together a Color B HST + Color A HST + Color B HST + 3 1/2" Background square, paying attention to the orientation of the HSTs. Press all seams in the opposite direction of the previous row. Make 2. Measures 3 1/2" x 12 1/2".



Sew the rows together as shown in the picture at the top. Press seams as desired. Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
