
2024 Brandon Quilters Block of the Month – Block 11 Tippecanoe and Tyler, Too

Cutting Instructions:



Color A Cut 1– 4 3/4" square Cut 4 – 4" squares


Color B Cut 2 – 3 7/8" squares, then cut in half on the diagonal. Cut 2 - 4" squares



Background Cut 2 – 4" squares Cut 1 – 7 1/2" square


With right sides together, center the long side of two Color B triangles on opposites side of the Color A 4 3/4" square. Stitch seam. Trim the dog ears. Press the seam away from the square.





Repeat with the remaining triangles on the other side of the square. Trim the dog ears. Press the seam away from the square. This unit should measure 6 1/2".





Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Color A 4" square. With right sides together, place 2 Color A squares on the Background 7 ½" square on opposite corners. Make sure your drawn line lines up and stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press the smaller Color A triangles away from the larger Background triangle created when cutting the square. Place the remaining Color A squares on the corner of the Background triangles. Stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line and press the smaller Color A triangles. Cut on the drawn line and press the smaller Color A triangles. Trim to 3 1/2" x 6 1/2". Makes 4 Flying Geese.



With right sides together, layer a 4" Color B square and a 4" Background square. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner and stitch 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut along the drawn line and press the Half Square Triangle (HST) open with the seam toward the Background fabric. Repeat with the last 2 squares. Trim the squares so they measure 3 1/2". Makes 4 Color B/Background HSTs.



Assemble the block in rows, paying attention to the orientation of the HSTs and Flying Geese. Press seams as desired.
