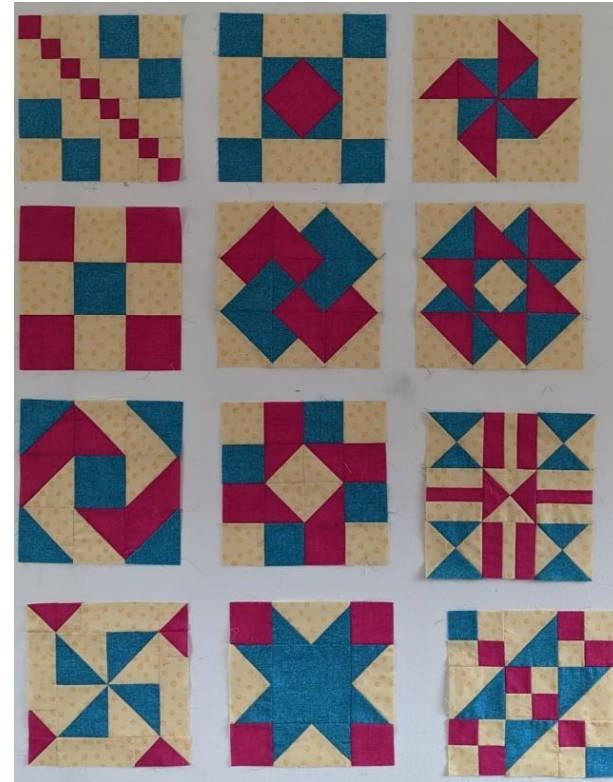

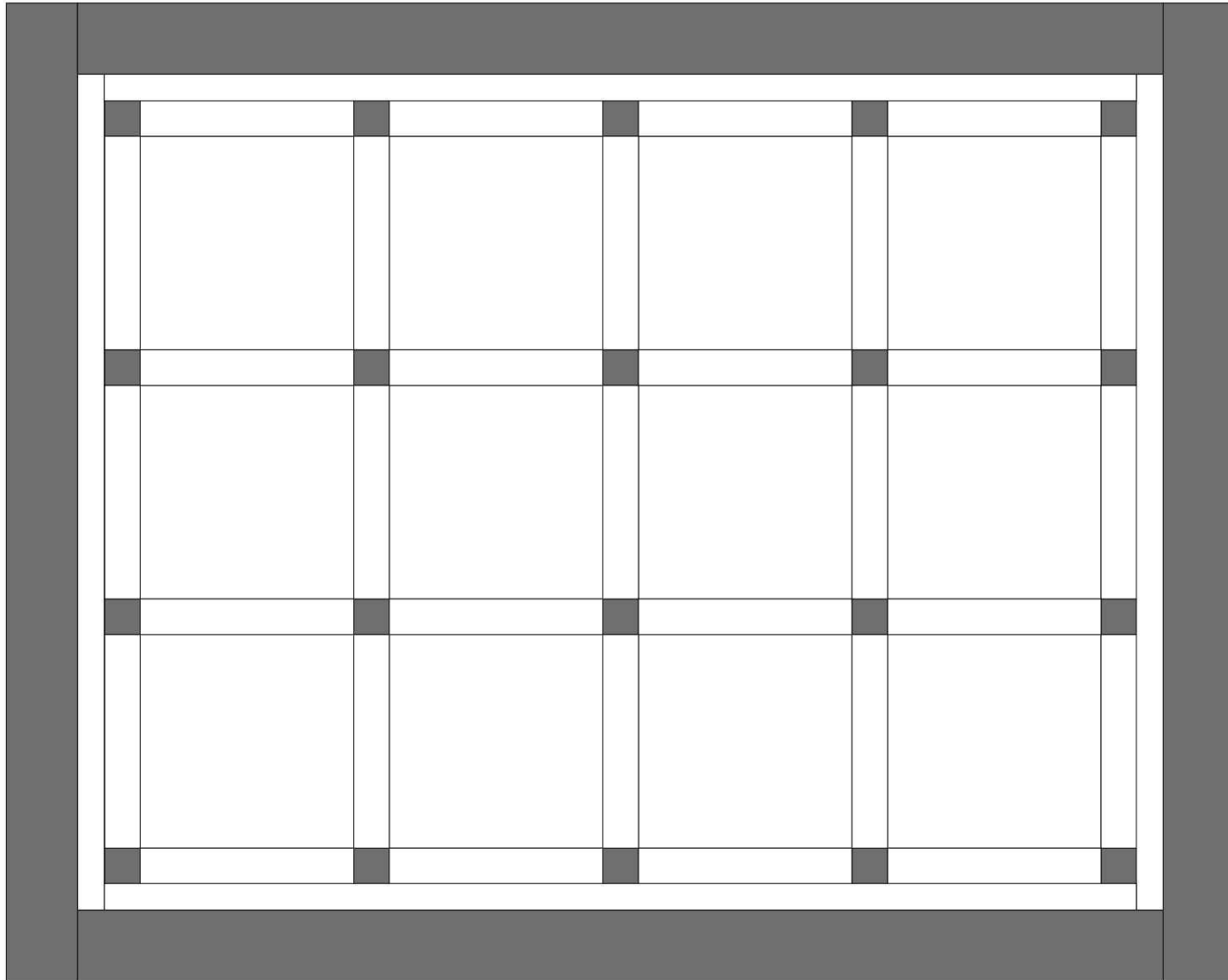


# Sashing and Cornerstones & Sashings





# Sashing and Cornerstones



- Cut 2 1/2" squares for cornerstones
- Cut 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" sashing strips
- Inner border is cut 2" wide
- Outer border is cut 4 1/2" wide
- Finished Quilt 55" x 69"

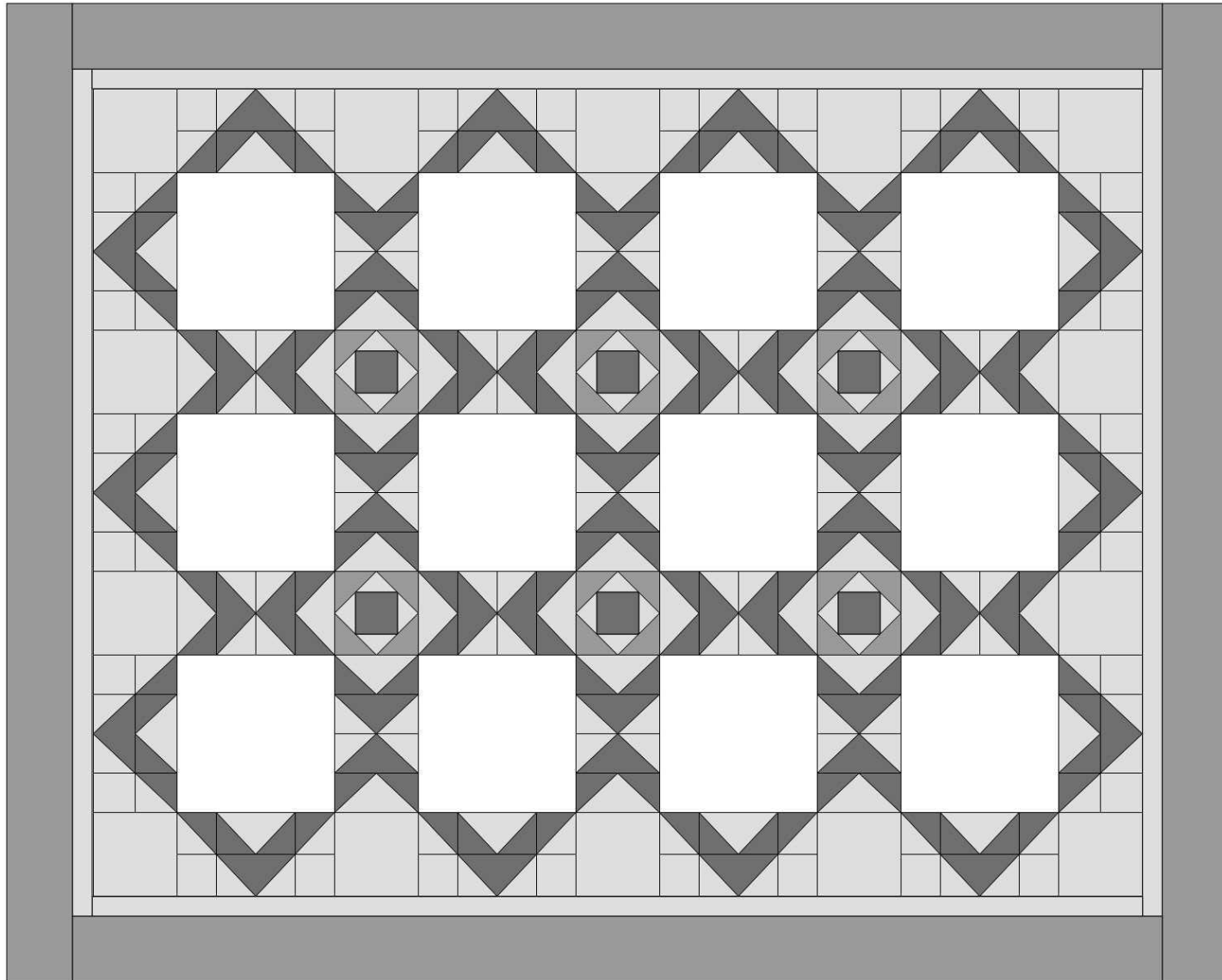


# Tweak the Sashing





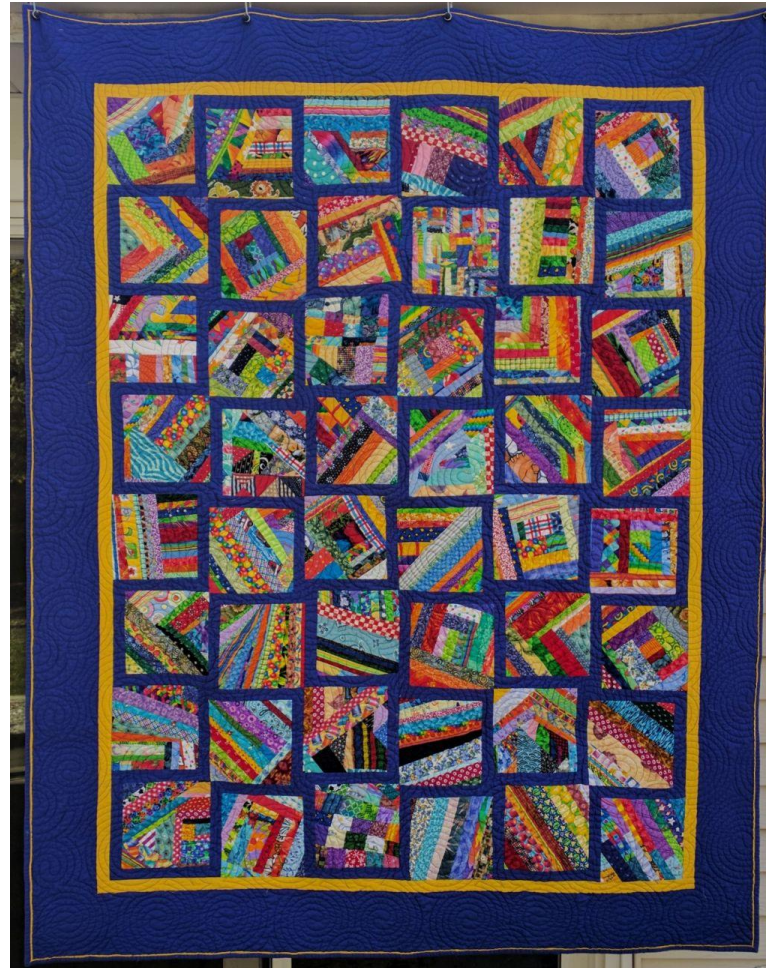
# 2022 QBHD Pizza Box Quilt



- 3" x 6" finished flying geese in 2 colorways
- Start with a 3 ½" square in the center of the cornerstone
- The next round uses a 4 ¼" square cut diagonally twice
- The final round uses 2 - 3 7/8" cut diagonally
- The inner border is cut 1 ½"
- The outer border is cut 5 ½"
- Finished Quilt 72" x 90"

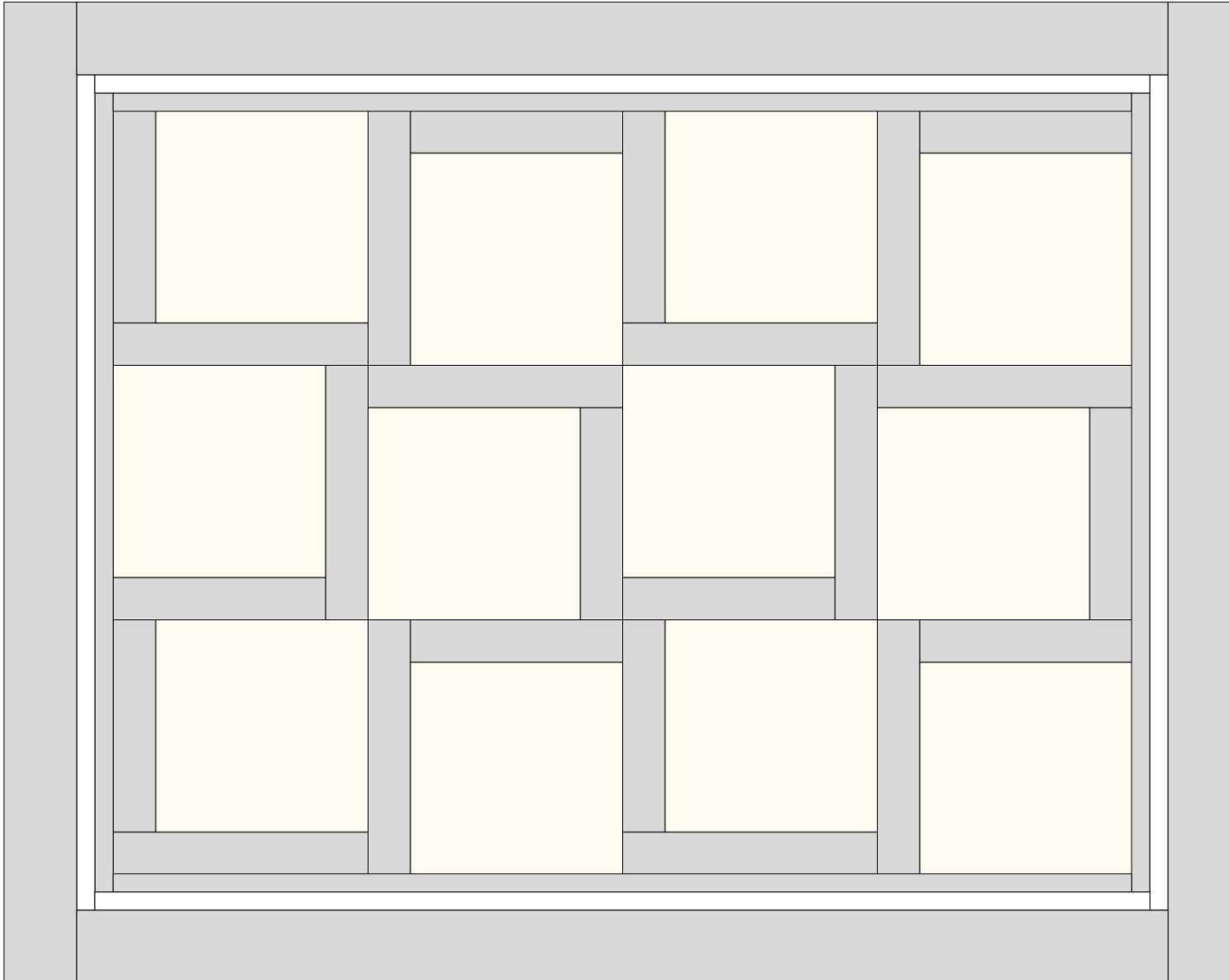


# Sashing on Only 2 Sides





# Autumn Leaves



- Cut sashing 2 ½” wide
- Cut inner border to match sashing 1 ½” wide
- Cut middle accent border 1 ½” wide
- Cut outer border 4 ½”

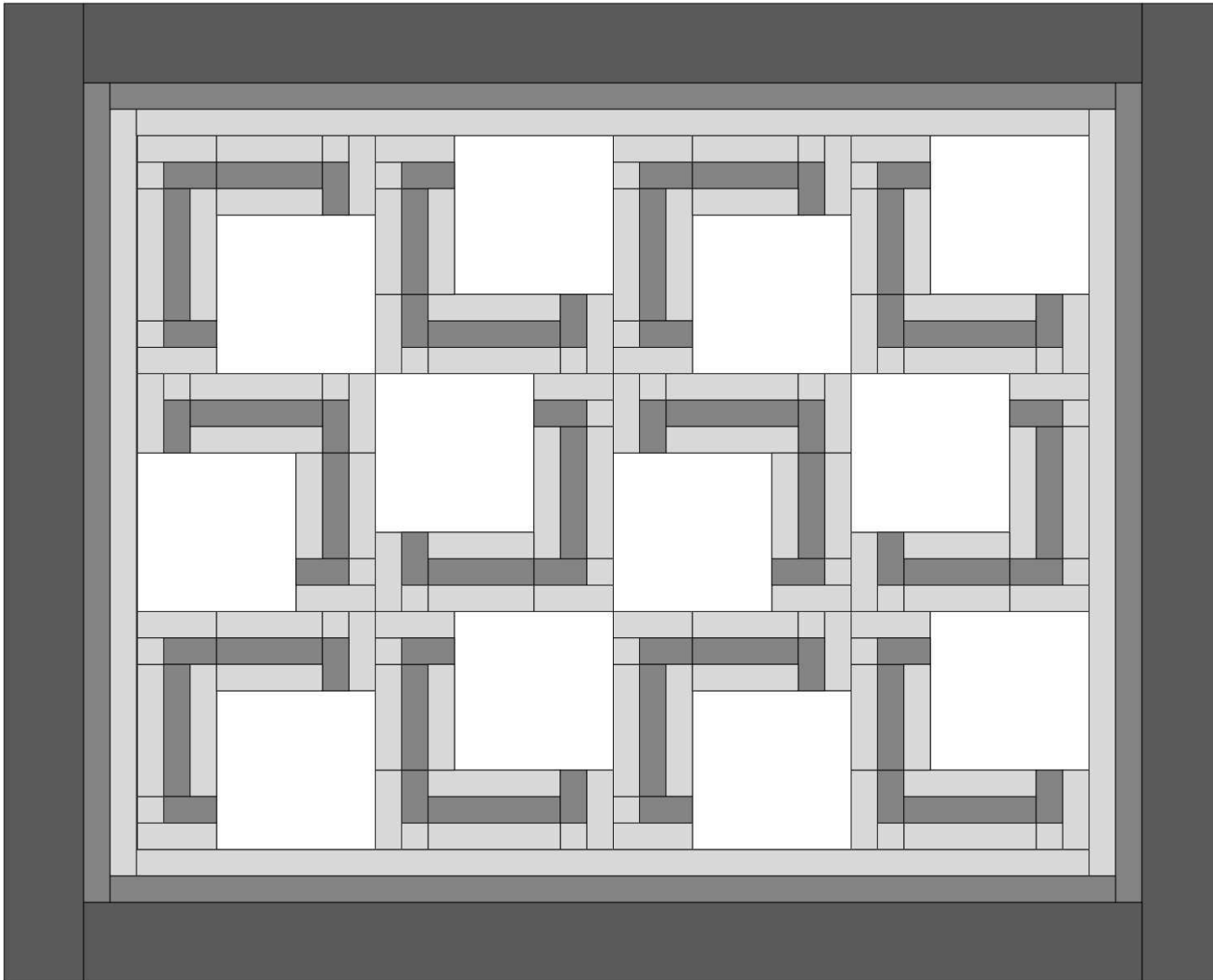


# Pieced Sashing on 2 Sides

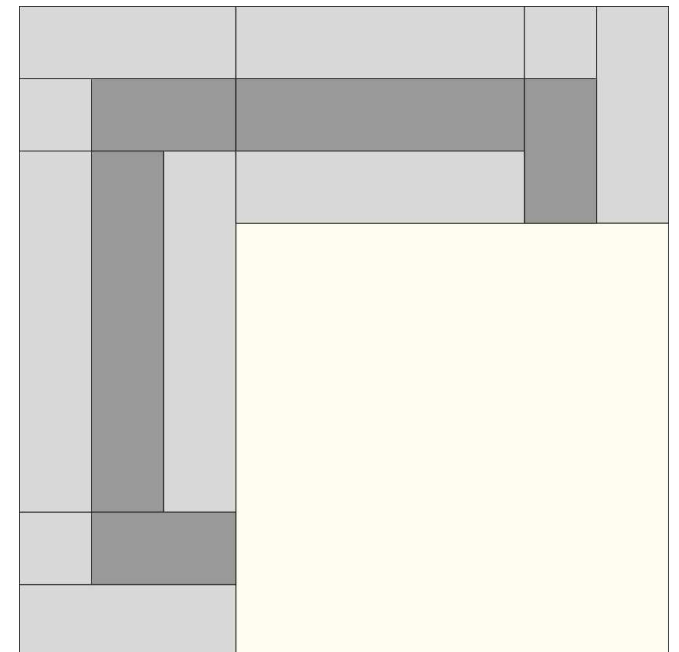




# Pieced Sashing on 2 Sides - Framed



- The sashing finishes at 6" wide
- The strips for the sashing are cut 2-1/2" wide.
- The inner and middle borders are cut 2 1/2" wide
- The outer border is cut 6 1/2" wide
- Finished Quilt 74" x 92"



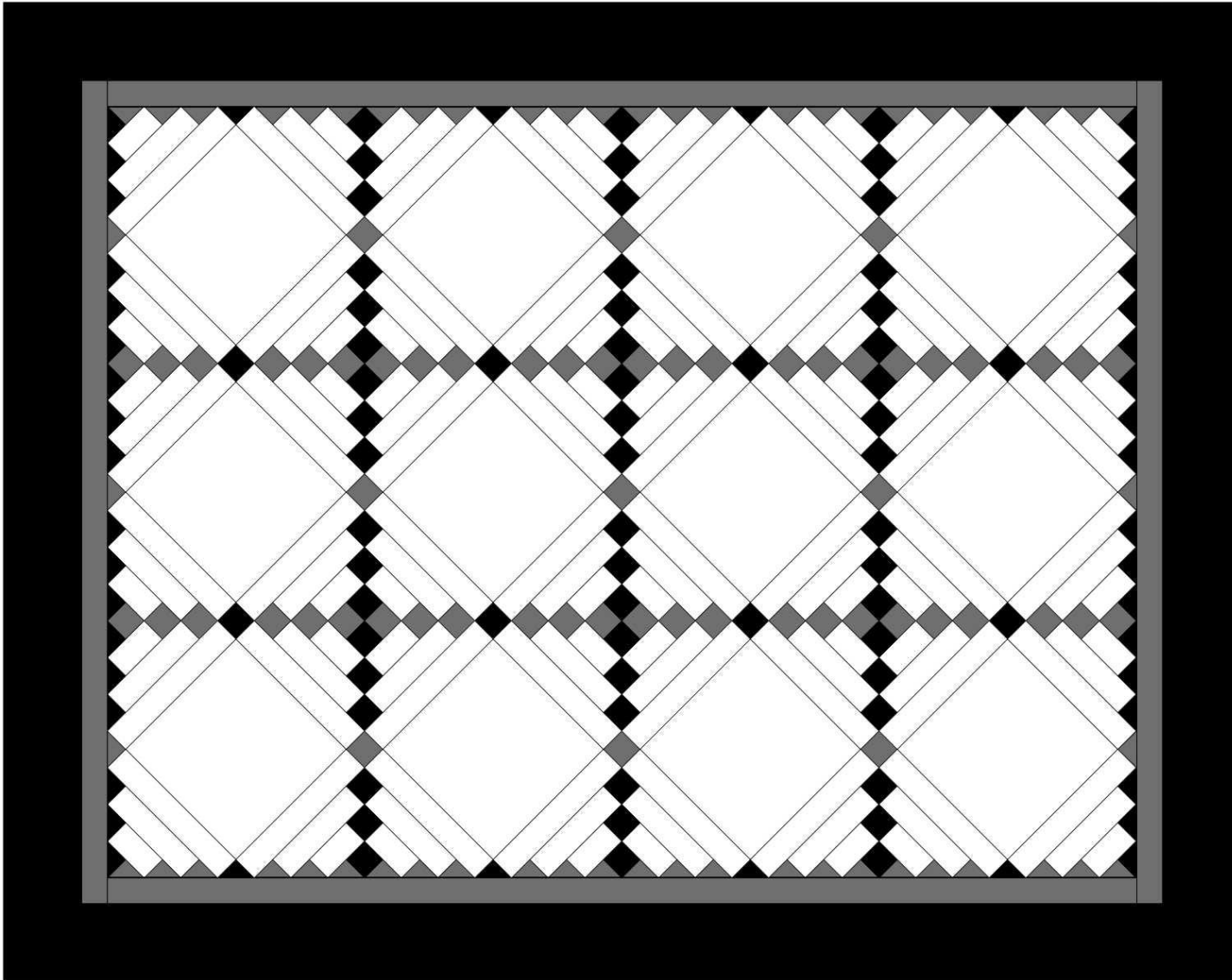

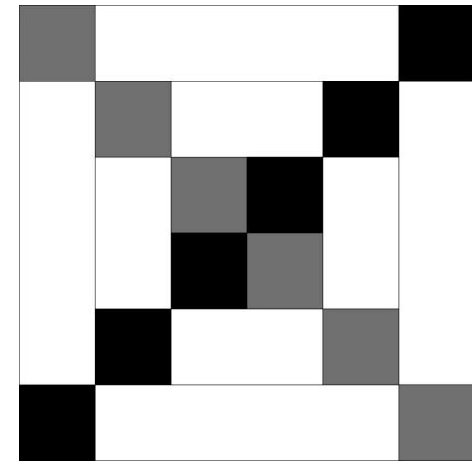




# Christmas Stars



- 12 1/2" unfinished Pennsylvania Blocks
- Cut Sashing 2 1/2" wide
- Alternating Cornerstones
- Inner border cut 2 1/2" wide
- Outer border cut 6 1/2" wide
- Finished quilt  $\approx 67" \times 84"$



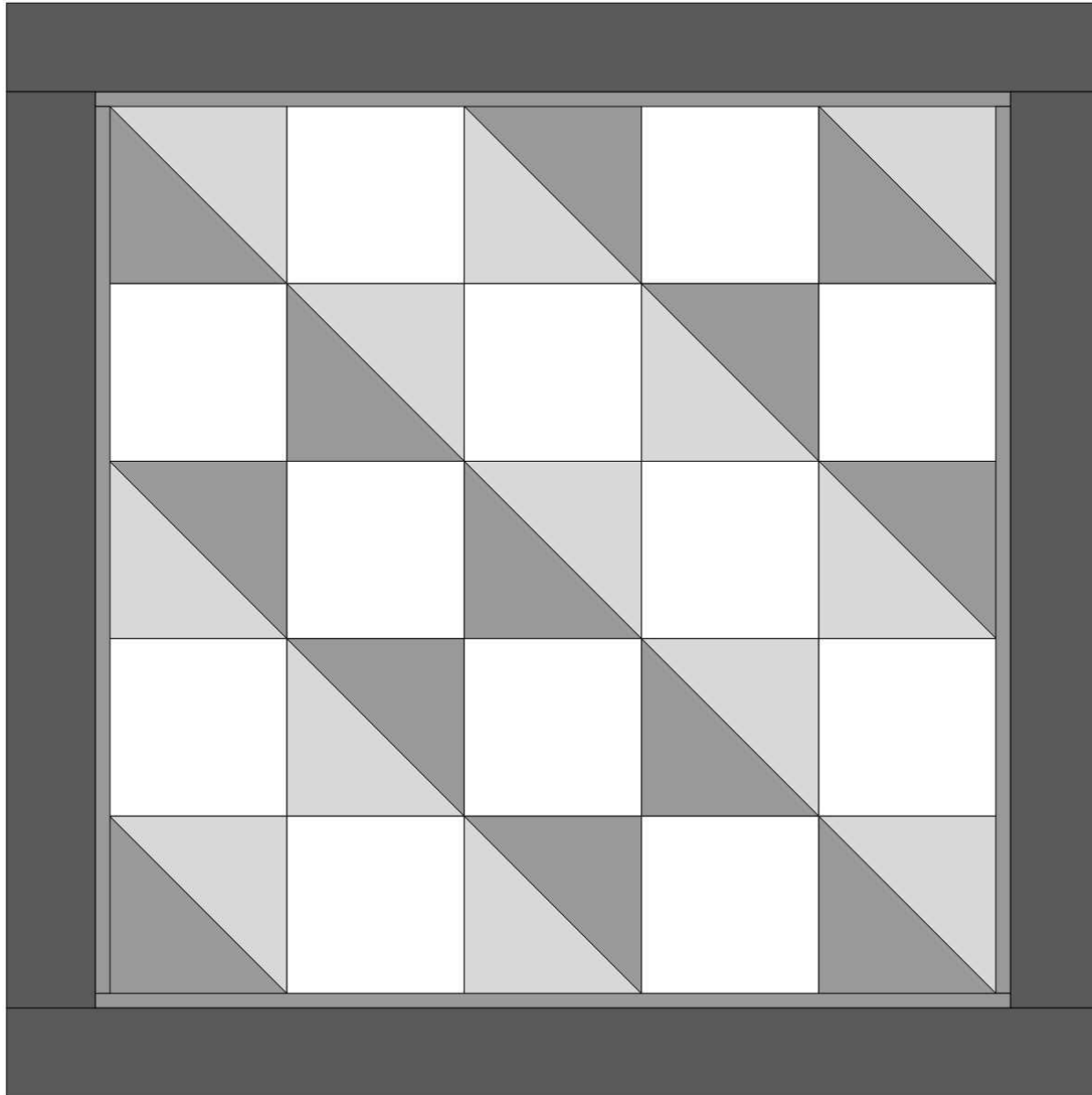


# Alternate Blocks – Field and Furrows





# Alternate Blocks – Field and Furrows



- 12 1/2" unfinished HST
- Inner border cut 1 1/2"
- Outer border cut 6 1/2"
- Finished quilt 72" x 72"

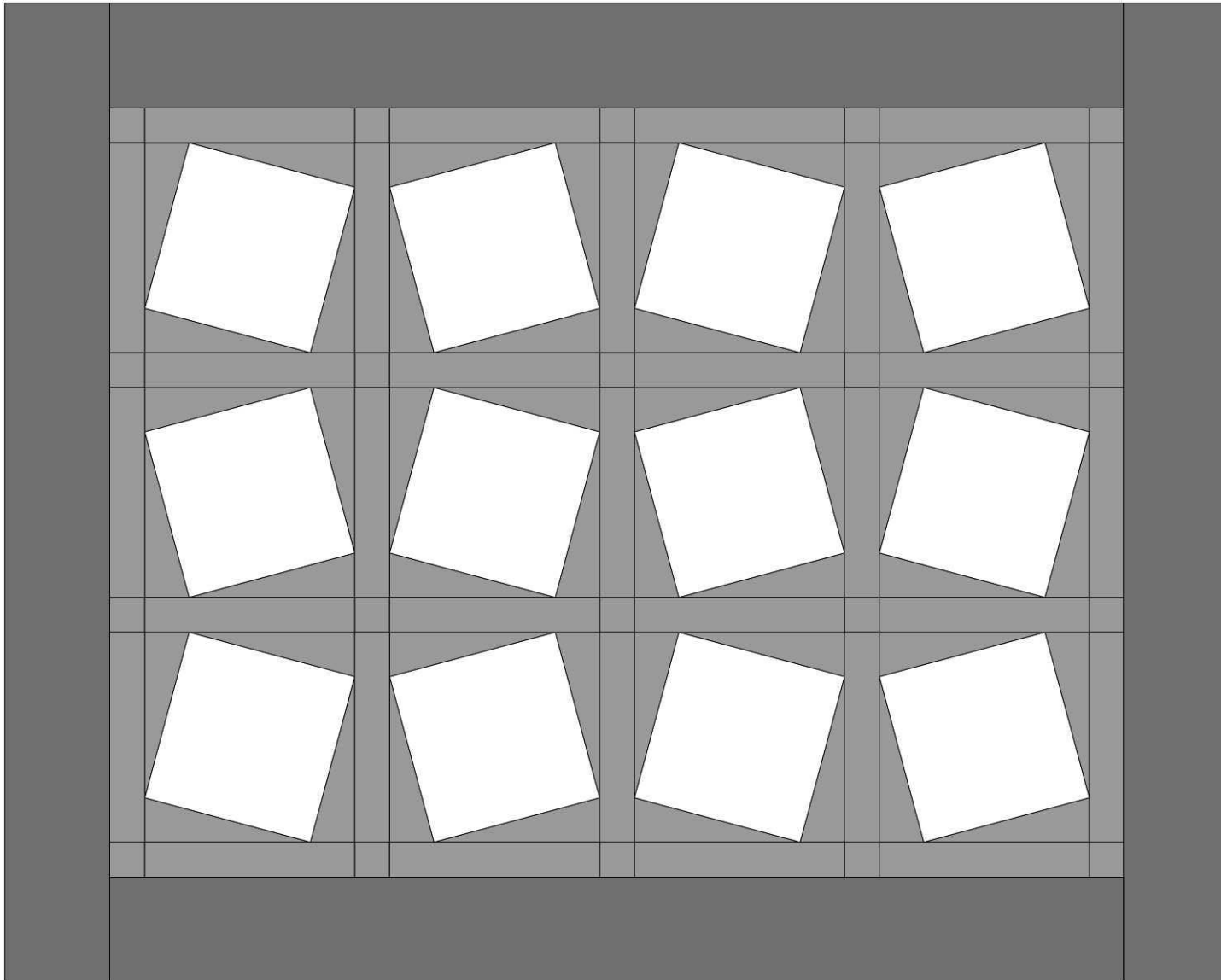




# Tilting Blocks



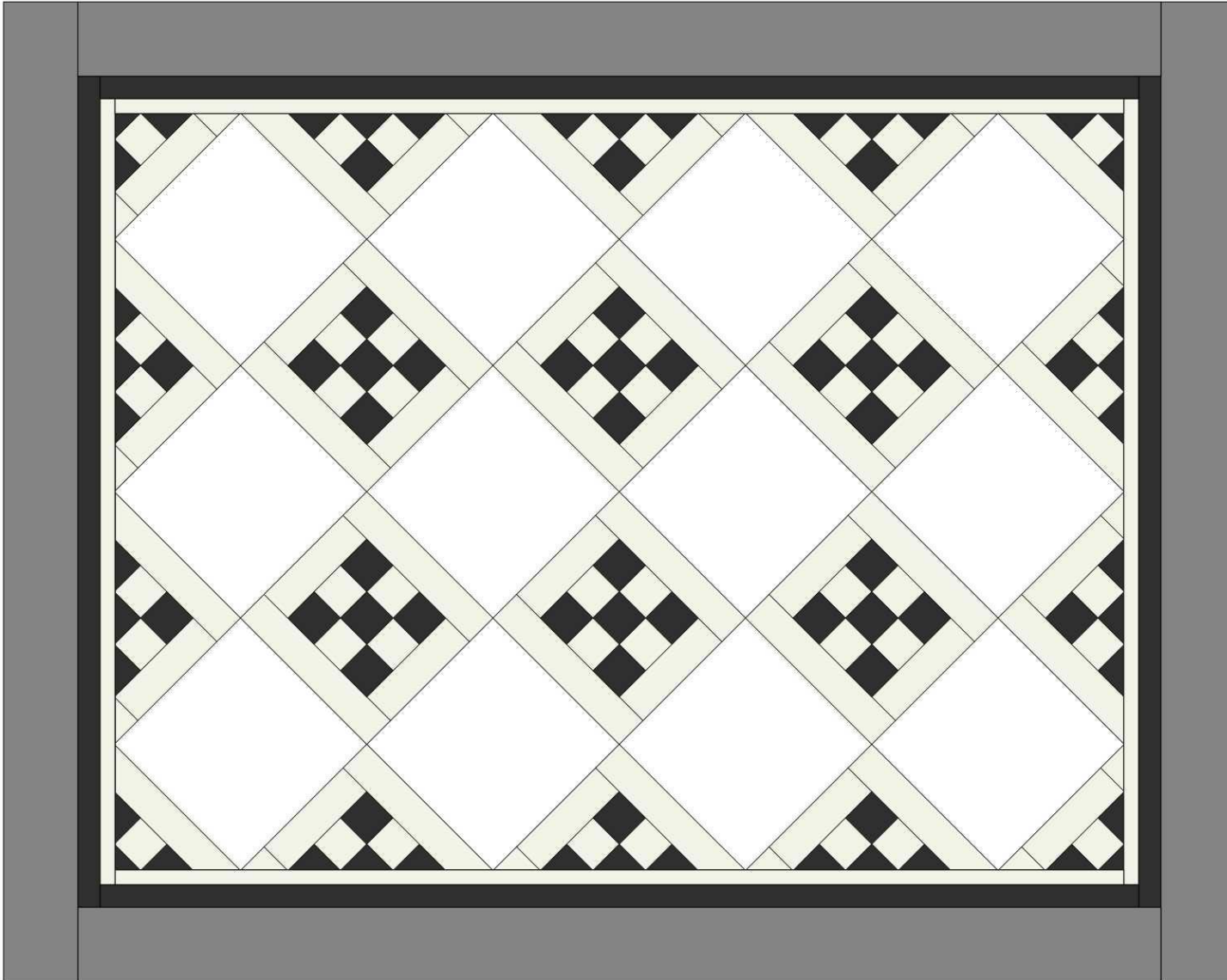
# Tilting Blocks



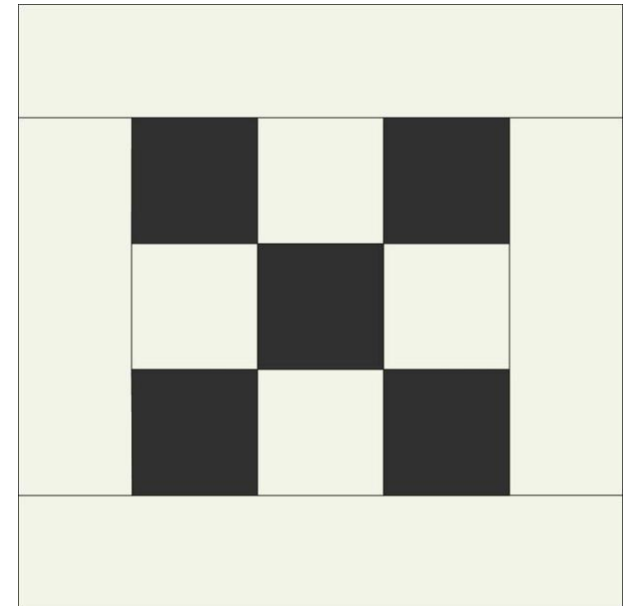
- Add 4" background framing to blocks
- Trim block to 15 ½" tilted at 15-degrees
- 2" sashing of background color including sash border
- 6" outer border
- Finished quilt 65" x 82"



# Framed Alternate Blocks

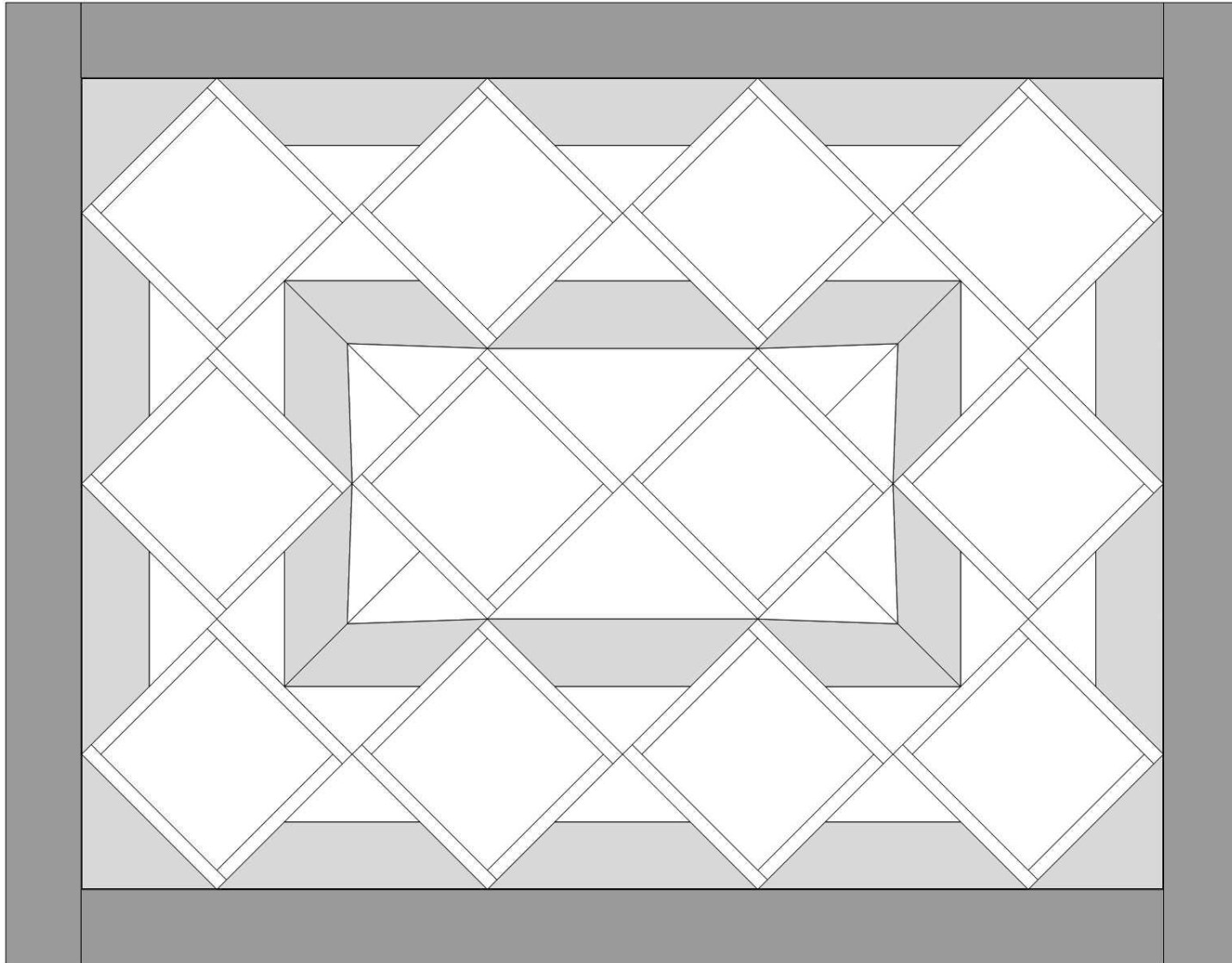


- Cut 3" squares for the 9-patch.
- Cut 2 ¾" strips for the frame
- The inner border is cut 1" wide
- The middle border is cut 2" wide
- The outer border is cut 5 ½" wide
- Finished quilt ≈ 66" x 83"

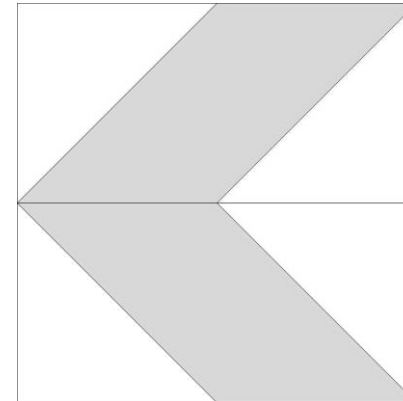




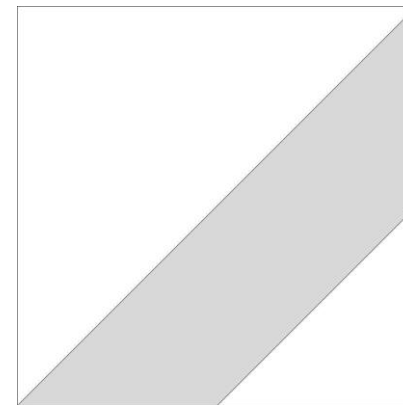
# Framed Pieced Blocks – So Sweet



- Cut framing strips 1½” wide
- Outer border cut 6” wide
- Finished quilt ≈ 70” x 90”

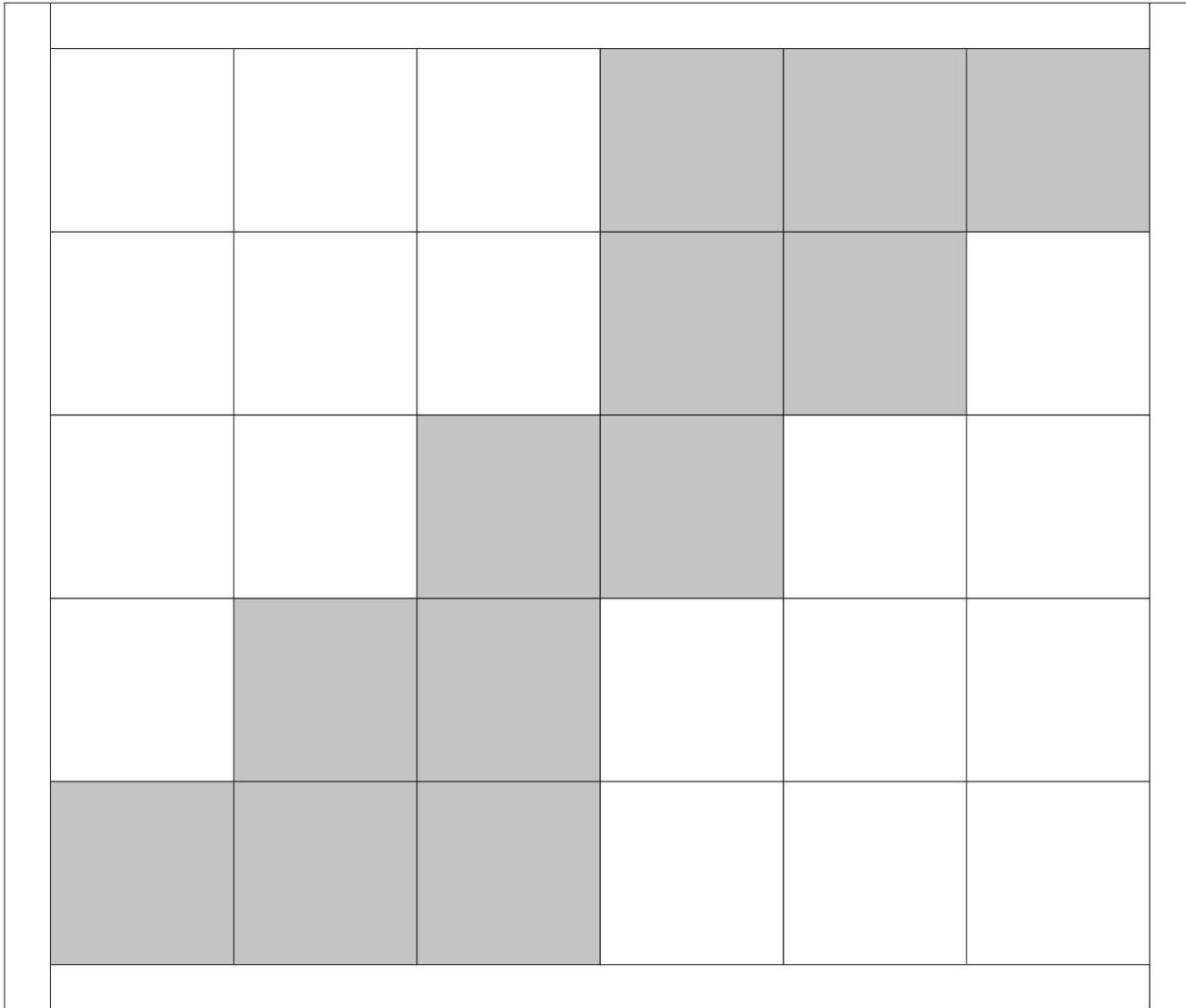


I cut 14 ½” x 7 ½” rectangles of the accent fabric and 7 ½” squares of background fabric to make snowball corners to make the interior corner blocks.



I cut 15” squares of the background and accent fabric to make HST which I trimmed to 14 ½” squares. Then I used a 7 ½” square of background fabric to make snowball corners.

# A Modern Twist



- Cut 12 ½” squares of background fabric or Cut 12 ½” strips of background fabric and piece to 24 ½” wide, 36 ½” wide and 48 ½” wide as I did.
- Border is cut 3 ½” wide
