#### February 3, 2025 minutes -

The meeting was called to order by president Pam Avara. There were 40 members and one visitor, Peggy Cote in attendance.

Pam introduced our speaker for tonight, Fire Chief Jackie Squires of the Star Fire Department. After he spoke donation quilts were shown by those that brought them tonight. Chief Squires stated he appreciated each quilter's generosity, talent and time in making and donating quilts.

Our business meeting began after Chief Squires exited. Pam asked for a motion to accept the minutes as printed in the January newsletter. Corrections to the Gulf States Quilters Association website was requested (.org not .com as noted) and correction to the dates of the MQA upcoming Spring Gathering. The minutes were then approved with corrections by Kathleen Greer and Beth Sonnier made the second and all approved.

MQA report from Kathleen Greer, the Spring Gathering will be held in Hattiesburg at the convention center, this Friday and Saturday, February 7th and 8th. Southern Fiber Artists are presenting the Friday night program, displaying and discussing their Mississippi exhibit of small art quilts from artists all over the state.

Christy Calhoun invited all to attend the Wynndale Quilters meetings being held the second Thursday each month. On March 13th and 14th there will be a two-day sit-n-sew. All are welcome to attend. Please bring your machine, projects and lunch.

A new guild has been started in Clinton, meeting at the Clinton library on the second Saturday of each month. They will have a business meeting and then Sit-n-Sew to follow each month. Their first meeting had sixty-seven in attendance.

Debbie Wilson gave us the 2025 retreat dates of September 18-21. A deposit of \$50 is required when registering for the retreat. Registration sheets with additional information are at our sign in desk. The cost does include 3 nights and 10 meals. The full balance of the retreat is due at our August meeting.

Karin Brown presented the folded Pinwheel Surprise quilt block during our Tips, Tricks and Tools.

Pam stated that her President's Challenge quilt block instructions are located on our website as well as the 2025 Mystery Quilt. Both are found under "Activities".

Regular Sew-n-Tell was shared and our meeting was adjourned.

Many quilts were shown and then given to Chief Squires after he spoke for distribution as needed by the fire fighters.
















