

Clue #4—Flying Geese in 2 Colorways

These instructions are for making No-Waste or 4-At-A-Time Flying Geese. The unit should measure 2 1/2"x 4 1/2" before sewing into the quilt. If using a different method do not use these cutting instructions. Make 16 geese in both Colorway 1 and Colorway 2 for the small quilt and 60 geese in each colorway for the large quilt.



	Cut into 5 1/2" Squares	Need 4 squares	Need 15 squares
Color C	3" Strip WOF	2 strips	5 strips
	Cut into 3" Squares	Need 16 squares	Need 60 squares

Fabric	Size	Small	Large
Background	5 1/2" Strip WOF	1 strip	3 strips
	Cut into 5 1/2" Squares	Need 4 squares	Need 15 squares
Color B	3" Strip WOF	2 strips	5 strips
	Cut into 3" Squares	Need 16 squares	Need 60 squares



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Clue #4—Flying Geese in 2 Colorways

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each 3" Color C square. With right sides together, place 2 Color 2 squares on the 5-1/2" Color B square on opposite corners. Make sure your drawn line lines up and stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line and press the smaller Background triangles away from the larger Color B triangle created when cutting the square. Place the remaining Color C squares on the corner of the Color B triangles. Stitch 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press the smaller Background triangles away from the larger Color B triangle. Trim to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Each goose unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"



Repeat the above steps using the 3" Color C squares and the 5-1/2" Background Squares.
